

A School Board Election was held on Nov 6, 2007 to elect new school board members for District 10JTR (Bayfield). Only Bayfield residents received election ballots for this election.

Winners in this elections included Bill Faust, Scott Kujath (incumbents) and Donald Mooney.

Votes cast were as follows: Faust (985), Kujath (974), Mooney (844), Eckstein (455), Folk (457).

Concerning the Bayfield Sanitation District question, 458 votes were cast in favor of dissolving the district, while 55 voters said NO.

A Candidate Forum was held for District 10JTR candidates on Wednesday, October 24 at the Pine River Library in Bayfield. Please click [school board election flyer](#) for details. With the tragic and untimely death of Candidate Mark Dold on Sunday, October 14, Padraig Lynch will assume the open and uncontested seat in District 9R. As a result there was no election for District 9R and the Candidate Forum planned for October 15 in Durango was cancelled.

The Ignacio 11JT School Board Election was uncontested, with three candidates running for the three open seats: as a result there was no election and the Candidate Forum was canceled at Ignacio Administration request.
