

Primary Election Highlights and Dates (Mail-In Election)

- July 12 – Last day to register to vote for the Primary Election
- July 12 – Last day to change or withdraw from a major political party affiliation.
(Registered unaffiliated electors may declare a major political party affiliation at the Clerk & Recorder’s office at 98 Everett St, Ste C, for the Primary Election)
- July 19-23 – Ballots will be mailed
- July 27-August 10 – Drop-off locations will accept mail ballots delivered by electors

General Election Highlights and Dates (Polling Place Election)

- October 4 - Last day to register to vote for the General Election
- October 12 – First day mail-in ballots will be sent to voters with mail-in requests.
- October 18 - Early voting begins at the La Plata County Clerk & Recorder’s office and Bayfield Town Hall
- October 26 – Last day to apply for a mail-in ballot for the General Election if mailed
- October 29 – Last day for early voting at the La Plata County Clerk & Recorder’s office and Bayfield Town Hall for the General Election
- November 2 – General Election, polls open 7:00 am to 7:00 pm. All mail-in ballots due by 7:00 pm.
